## **Annual Contact Lens Agreement & Explanation of Contact Lens Exam and Fitting Fees**

For existing contact lens wearers, a contact lens evaluation is required annually in order to maintain a valid prescription. The cost for the contact lens evaluation starts at \$60. For wearers that require a specialty lens or a substantial change in prescription, a contact lens re-fitting is required. Re-fitting fees range from \$85-\$100. For new contact lens wearers, the fit and evaluation ranges from \$100-\$125. (These charges are explained in more detail on the back of this page.) Contact lens evaluations and fitting fees are non-refundable.

As a contact wearer, I am aware:

- Contact lenses are medical devices that should be monitored by my doctor. My doctor will determine my current prescription and health of my eyes to ensure successful contact lens wear.
- Annual exams are necessary to continue replacing contacts. There is an additional charge for the contact lens fitting, which must be performed yearly.

**\*\*Note:** Contact lens fitting and follow up must be completed within 60 days of the original exam date. After this time additional charges will apply.

- There is an increased risk of infection or corneal ulcers that can lead to loss of vision with contact wear. This risk increases if the contacts are worn as extended wear. Complying with wearing times, care regimens, and disposal schedules can help to greatly minimize this risk.
- If prolonged redness of the eyes, pain, or irritation occurs, I should remove the lenses and call this office immediately.
- I should wear sunglasses because UV light can cause cataracts, macular degeneration, and pingueculae.
- I need to have my correct prescription in a pair of back up glasses. Glasses are extremely important in case of infection and to keep my eyes healthy.

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### Contact Lens Professional Fees

**Contact Lens Reevaluation** **\$ 60**

Contact lens reevaluation is the yearly evaluation of the fit and vision of an existing pair of contact lenses on established wearer which results in *no change*, and only an update of contact lens power. This is normally performed and completed during the comprehensive yearly exam. This includes 60 days of follow-up, if needed.

**Contact Lens Refitting** **\$85 - \$100**

Contact lens refitting is the yearly evaluation of the fit and vision of an existing pair of contact lenses on an established wearer which results in significant *change* of lens design. Patient will usually require diagnostic lenses prior to ordering new supply and at least 1-2 follow-ups. This includes 60 days of follow-up and necessary diagnostic lenses.

**Contact Lens New Fitting**

A contact lens new fitting is for those *new* to contact lens wear, or those that have been unsuccessful contact lens wearers in the past. This fee includes the training done with a contact lens technician, a starter kit, 60 days of follow-up, and the necessary diagnostic lenses to insure a well fitting and comfortable contact lens. There are different levels of pricing based upon complexity and the expected number of follow-ups.

**Standard** **\$100** Spherical soft or RGP with nightly removal of contacts

**Advanced** **\$125** Continuous wear (sleep-in variety), presbyopic correction, and astigmatism correction
